RAMPART RESERVOIR TRAIL: (Forest Service Trail #700) Drive west on Hwy 24 to Woodland Park. Turn right at the McDonald's to the Rampart Range Road. Drive past the Woodland Park Schools and through a residential area. Follow the signs to Rampart Reservoir. The trail can be accessed from various points around the reservoir. One access point to the trail is from "Rainbow Gulch," on the Rampart Range Road, about 1.5 miles west of the junction of FDR 306 and Rampart Range Road (FDR 300). Rainbow Gulch is a good winter access because the gate at FDR 306 is closed in the winter. This trail is 11.6 miles long, follows the lake shoreline and is rated as an easy trail. Because of the many access points, the hiker has the option of doing small portions of the trail. MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED.
